

SCHEDULE FOR TEMPORARY MARKETS

A person operating a retail shop at a temporary market is exempted from the Retail Trading Hours Act 1987 if –

- (a) the temporary market is conducted at a time and place approved by the Chief Executive Officer;
- (b) the retail shop is a stall that is erected at the commencement of, and dismantled at the conclusion of, the temporary market; and
- (c) only goods specified in the Schedule are sold from the retail shop.
